### ● Learn About the Pioneers

- Use [www.familysearch.org/campaign/pioneers](http://www.familysearch.org/campaign/pioneers) to see if you have any LDS pioneers in your family or find ancestors alive during 1840-1860. Look through their pictures and memories. If you don't have any LDS pioneer ancestors, you can still learn about other pioneers in your family!
- Share their story with your family
- Make and illustrate a little book about their story
- Act out one of their stories
- Write in your journal how their story can help you today

### ● Have a Pioneer Experience

- Try a pioneer game like Stick Pull, Kick the Can, Checkers, or Jacks
- Make pioneer food like homemade bread, butter, Brigham donuts, or taffy
- Listen to pioneer songs
- Watch a pioneer movie: 17 Miracles, Ephraim's Rescue, Legacy
- Do a pioneer craft
